


These drawings are inspired by the book A Method for Creative Design by Adolfo Best Maugard. He based his method on seven motifs taken from the mexican "primitive" arts and also from other cultures around the world. In his book he shows how to compose figurative and decorative designs with just seven types of lines: circle, half circle, wave, zigzag, S-line, line and spiral. He explains the relation of each of this motifs to nature, as well as composition, perspective and intuition in primitive art. In these drawings all motifs are used excepted for the spiral, which is the most complex line of all and full of significance.


